**Crime and Disorder Implications:**

**If approved, this funding will be used to support vulnerable females away from the risk of violence and abuse. Whilst it is hoped that this project reduces incidents of violence and abuse against these women, survivors and victims will be supported to report any crime committed against them.**

**Legal Advice:** There are no significant legal issues arising from this decision. The funding being offered under the Helix project by MHCLG requires a local authority lead applicant. The local authority will then act as the accountable body to flow the funding through to the other partners that will be delivering the project. The partners will all be responsible for delivering their own elements of the project in accordance with the bid submission. As the Council will be the accountable body it will need to ensure that it receives all necessary information from the partners to submit to MHCLG and to claim the funding and therefore a collaboration agreement is advised. This will set out the roles and responsibilities of each partner.

**Finance Advice:** This decision requests approval to accept £347,407 from MHCLG to act as the lead local authority working in collaboration with existing delivery partners. NCC will be responsible in allocating payments to those partners based on agreed plans and outcomes, ensuring those outcomes are fully met as well as adhering to the terms and conditions of the grant. It also requests that the Corporate director for Growth and City Development has the delegated authority to utilise any under spend from this grant within the Rough Sleepers project with approval from our MHCLG colleagues.  
  
This funding stream will be strictly monitored on a monthly basis and as this is fully covered by this grant, there will be no impact to the MTFP Advice provided by Michelle Pullen (Commercial Business Partner) on 30/09/2021.

**Procurement Advice:**

This decision relates to the award of £349,407 grant funding by the Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government (MGHLG) the Council to deliver the Helix Project and to enter into a collaboration agreement with the other delivery partners, Emmanuel House and Juno Women's Aid to deliver a one year pilot to provide short term emergency respite accommodation with intensive support to female rough sleepers who have experienced violence and abuse. As this is grant funding awarded against the partnership funding application, there are no procurement implications. In the use of this funding the terms and conditions of the MHCLG grant should be fully complied with and suitable agreements should be in place with these providers to ensure compliance and satisfactory performance.
