The walking subgroup has now completed 12 self-guided walks – the latest are Dunkirk and Beeston (published October 2021) and Park Steps and Tunnel (to be published January 2022).

We have around another half dozen or so walks either in development or as ideas. When these are completed we hope to have walks which touch every ward in the city. A list of completed and planned walks mapped against the city wards is attached separately. We noted that our walks both take in parks and green spaces in our city, but also provide connections between them.

Outside of LAF, Chris and Mike continue to work on the Leen Valley Long Distance Trail for which they are seeking funding. This will require joint work with Nottinghamshire County Council.

The Nottinghamshire Guided Walks Partnership, which Chris and Nigel lead, is aiming to publish the 2022 list of guided walks (including health walks) in March. Guided walk information is also available through the Notts Guided Walk website.

Following the October LAF meeting, Rob Kirkwood from NOSF facilitated contact between the LAF and the recently formed Green Space Walking Network Nottinghamshire (part of "Greenspace" – a partnership approach to Green Social Prescribing in Nottingham and Nottinghamshire). Liz attended their initial meeting in December and a second meeting is planned for January 10th.
