Tomorrow's NUH

Report of the Head of Legal and Governance

1 Purpose

- 1.1 To consider the findings from the second phase of pre-consultation engagement on proposals for services under the Tomorrow's NUH programme; and next steps.

2 Action required

- 2.1 The Committee is asked to consider whether it wishes to make any comments or recommendations about the development of proposals under the Tomorrow's NUH programme.

3 Background information

- 3.1 Colleagues from Nottingham and Nottinghamshire Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) have attended Committee meetings on five occasions to provide briefings on the Tomorrow's NUH programme: 17 September 2020, 12 November 2020, 14 January 2021, 15 July 2021 and 17 March 2022. In addition, some Committee members have attended an informal briefing session on specific thinking in relation to cancer and maternity services under the programme.
- 3.2 Proposals for services under the programme are likely to involve substantial variations or developments of service, and therefore the CCG has a statutory duty to consult this Committee, in addition to conducting a full public consultation.
- 3.3 The CCG has the statutory duty to develop the pre-consultation business case describing the proposed major service changes and ensure appropriate consultation and engagement. In March, the Committee heard about the work that had taken place so far to develop current proposals and plans for the second phase of pre-consultation engagement on revisions that had been made to proposals as they had developed. The Committee requested information about the findings of this second phase of pre-consultation to help assess how those findings are being used to shape final proposals and the extent to which proposals are in the best interests of local health services.
- 3.4 Attached is a briefing on the consultation carried out and the key findings. Representatives of the CCG will be attending the meeting to discuss this with the Committee.
