Reasons for the Decision(s)	The Theatre Royal and Royal Concert Hall (TRCH) presents around 675 performances each year, attracting audiences in excess of
	600,000 TRCH supplies a range of confectionery and soft drinks at each performance. This enhances the customer experience as well as generating a significant income stream to support the TRCH programme. Anticipated spend is £87,500 per annum for four years.
	Expenditure is funded through TRCH revenue budgets.
Other Options Considered:	The Council already has a contract in place with Brakes for the provision of these supplies so it would be inefficient and unnecessary to
	procure these supplies outside of this contract.

Finance Advice:	The approved medium term financial plan (MTFP) for financial year 2022/23 includes a budgeted net income target for the theatre royal and concert hall (TRCH) of £5.064m. Within this income target is an expectation of sales from confectionary items. Failure to achieve this income target would give rise to an overspend position. The approved supplier will need to meet TRCH's operational needs in terms of range of products and timely deliveries to meet customer demand and to maximise income generation from sales.
