To test the market through a procurement process and work in partnership with a profit share to deliver a PT service.	
Reasons for Decision and Background Information	
In the last few months, since returning from Covid there has been an increase in customer comments through feedback asking for additional support to help with their fitness routines.	
Offering a PT service through an external company will provide a professional service to customers, without any additional budget cost to the council, along with the opportunity of a small amount of additional income for any surplus profit share through the partnership.	

This will offer our Residents a specialised service to help support them further with their Health and Fitness.

Improved retention and improved length of stay has been demonstrated through industry reports when having a PT service on offer to members as an option, which would be positive for retaining business income.
