

FIRST VARIATION TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Memorandum of Understanding (“the MoU”) Title: Local Energy Capacity Support 2022/23

Date of the MoU: 27/10/2022

Between:

- (1) The Secretary of State for Business, Energy, and Industrial Strategy (hereinafter called “**the Secretary of State**”); and
- (2) Nottingham City Council (hereinafter called “**the Authority**”)

Date of this Amendment: 10/03/2023

The MoU is varied as follows:

1. Words and expressions in this variation shall have the meanings given to them in the MoU.
2. The MoU, including any previous variations, shall remain effective and unaltered except as amended by this variation.
3. The Authority will as soon as possible and by 31st March 2023 at the latest provide the Secretary of State with a signed copy of this Variation to the MoU.
4. In addition, the Authority will as soon as possible and by 31st March 2023 at the latest provide the Secretary of State with a signed copy of the section 151 officer declaration in the form set out in Annex 3 of the original MoU and the completed grant claim form in the form set out in Annex 5 of the original MoU.

Paragraph 13 is amended as follows:

The Secretary of State will grant the Authority funding to the following value (“**the Grant**”) to deliver the objectives in line with the Scope [para 12] in the Original MoU. This funding is subject to the Authority providing the documentation and information in accordance with Annex 1.

Grant Amount	Proposed Task
£85,000	E-cargo: The provision, delivery and installation of two e-Cargo bike parklet style bays to inform scalability decisions.
£35,000	Hartlebury Energy from Waste Plant - Carbon reduction/ Capture study
£20,000	Oakengates Leisure Centre - Undertake an Energy model and study for energy saving to the Pool and Gym Area to inform future capital spending decisions.
£5,000	Cool Shropshire & Telford Business Support for carbon saving and sustainable business practices
