Reasons for Decision and Background Information	
The role has established the Adult Social care programme and is now required to ensure the integrated plan is embedded and delivers on the programme's expectations for service change and the financial delivery included in the 2023/24+ Medium Term Financial Plan (MTFP). This plan includes an extension of savings originally captured in the 2022/23 MTFP.	

This role is responsible for a mixture of coaching and supporting council staff across a broad portfolio of Adult Social Care change projects at all levels of the organisation. They will oversee a complex portfolio of work, supporting in the design of projects, create processes, engage stakeholders, manage priorities, track progress, and assign activity across programmes, projects and delivery teams.

The capacity, skillset and experience is not currently available within the organisation.

Procurement of this resource is in accordance with the appropriate processes (ESPO Framework 3S_22 – Strategic HR Services) and funding will be allocated from the Improvement & Transformation fund current allocation.
