This payment therefore needs to be spent by 30/12/23 otherwise the Council is contractually obliged to repay it.

Of the projects listed in Appendix 2, one is valued above £100k and 5 above £25k, and the contracts for these must be awarded subsequent to obtaining a minimum of three written tenders / quotes respectively, in accordance with Article 18.55 of the Constitution; unless existing corporate contracts or compliant arrangements established by third parties are used in accordance with Article 18.34 or 18.43, as applicable. The remainder of the projects listed are valued below £25k and can be awarded contracts subject to Contract Procedure Rules. Advice should be sought from the Procurement Team to ensure all appointments are made compliantly, and that applicable provisions of both Contract Procedure Rules and the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 are adhered to.
