Written question to be asked by Councillor Kevin Clarke of the Leader of the Council at the meeting of the City Council to be held on 15 January 2024

Could the Portfolio Holder tell the Chamber and the citizens what was the final cost of installing the fountains in Market Square in 2007?

Councillor David Mellen replied as follows:

Records retained by Nottingham City Council in relation to the Old Market Square water feature indicate a final cost of approx. £1m and this work was part of a much larger project funded by the East Midlands Development Agency, Greater Nottingham Partnership, the Government Office for the East Midlands and the European Commission. It should be noted this value stated is as of 23 July 2008. There are no further records on this item.
