Reasons for Decision and Background Information

Strategic Assets and Property (SA & P) have been instructed on behalf of the Deputyship Team, Adult Social Care to act as agents to value and sell a private residential property, 53 Candle Meadow, Colwick Park, Nottingham. The owner of the property is now under full time care with no immediate family or power of attorney in place.

The asset has been valued in-house with input from three local estate agents and a local auctioneer, this shows that a guide price of £130,000 would be appropriate to

secure a sale at best consideration. The Deputyship Team have been consulted on this basis and they have instructed us to proceed to a sale via private treaty.

Subject to this approval, SA & P will advertise the asset via Property Plus and Rightmove with all viewings will be conducted internally. It has been agreed that 1% of the sale price will be recovered to cover marketing, surveyors and legal fees associated with the sale.

Other Options Considered and why these were rejected

Not to grant to sell the property. This was rejected as it is in everyone's best interests to sell.

Reasons why this decision is classified as operational

The decision is under £150,000 and is regarded as best value for all parties.
