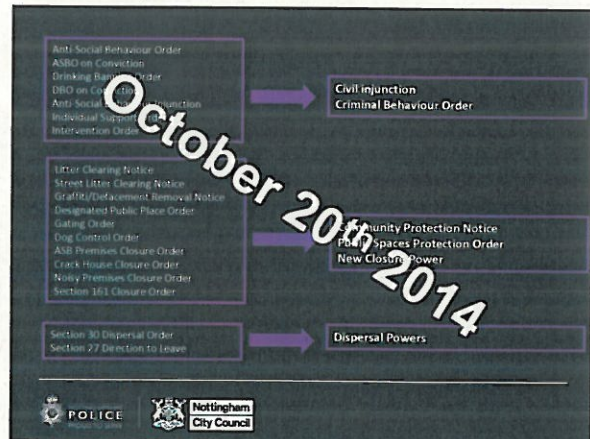
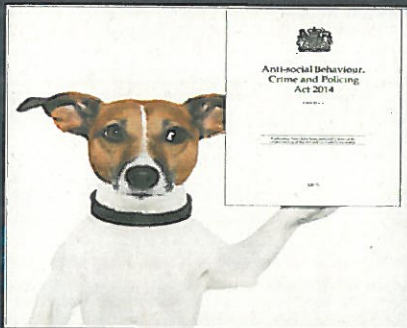

The concept of vulnerability recognises that some people and communities are more liable to being negatively impacted by ASB, often because they lack social, economic and psychological resilience to withstand the negative effects associated with such experiences.

- Dr Martin Innes (2011)

In the context of ASB a victim is vulnerable if the conduct in question causes an adverse impact on their quality of life. Adverse impact includes the risk of harm, deterioration of health and mental and emotional well being, or an inability to carry out normal day to day routine through fear and intimidation.



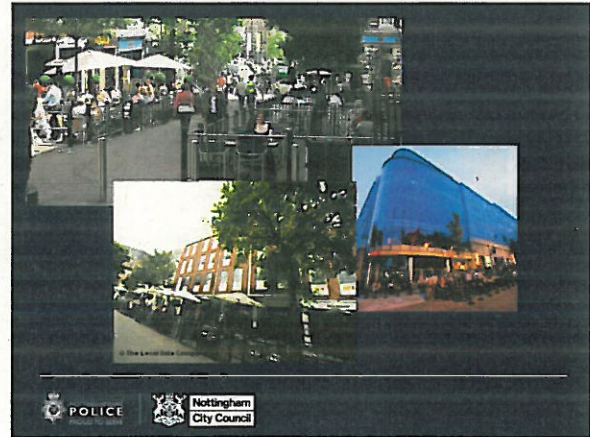
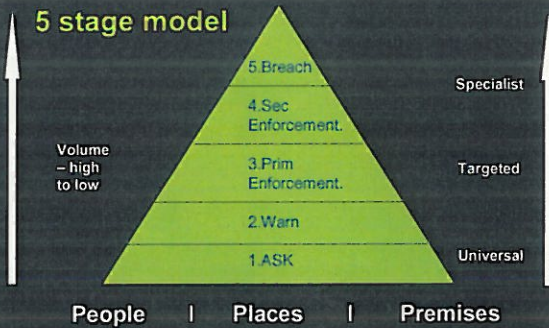
