

Reasons for the Decision(s)	Currently, we deploy all of the care workers within adult provision establishment across the estate, as circumstance dictate. We are finding that on a continuous basis we are having to deploy a Care Worker 3 to Springwood from Long Meadow and for this reason, makes it easier for accounting and deployment purposes to have this post transferred permenently to Springwood's staff establishment.

To deliver the savings in the Medium Term Financial Plan (MTFP) this needs to remain the case.			
	The service area have identified alternative budget which can be used to support the CWL3 at Springwood. The disestablishment of the Dementia Practioner Team will deliver on its identified MTFP savings target and also be able to transfer budget of £24,022 to Springwood.
