	proper tendering exercise) expires on 29 August 2015. A short extension to the existing contract is sought pending the completion of the restructuring of the Property Section because there is no in-house knowledge or expertise of the requisite lift
	management services and there is insufficient time to go out to tender before the existing contract ends.
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Other Options Considered:	1) Do Nothing - This is not an option as the existing contract for lift management services ends 29 Aug 2015 and the specialist
	knowledge to maintain aging Lift assets will be put at risk if the contract is not extended.
	2) Engage internal resource - This is not an option because there is not the internal resource with the requisite expertise.

If the necessary authority is given, the contract allows for a variation by written agreement of the parties; other than this the terms and conditions will remain the same. The proposal to extend the existing contract for 12 months to 1st September 2016 will require dispensation from Financial Regulation Finance Advice: 3.29 (to dispense with the requirement to obtain at least 3 written quotes). The total cost of £19,000 will fall into financial years 2015-16 (£11,000) and 2016-17 (£8,000). The cossts will be funded from the £4.344m Planned Maintenance budget.
