

Successful delivery of Youth Contract (Step in to Work)

- 145 Young people have received support across Area 3 and been provided with Careers Advice
- 31 Young people have received help with English & Maths
- 93 Young people have taken part in training activities
- 32 Young people have started jobs
- Young people have started Apprenticeships
- 12 Young people have completed Work Experience



Successful delivery of Youth Contract (Step in to Work)

What worked well?

- Mentoring approach
- Having the base at ACTC within the community
- Promotional activity has raised self-referrals

Where can we do better?

- Need to increase promotional activity to reach more young people
- We need more local partners, more referral bases
- We need to ensure we engage with more employers

- Promoting our services to residents
- Introducing us to partners
- Identifying potential employers





Increasing referrals to Nottingham Jobs Fund & Nottingham Jobs Hub


What worked well?

- Regular meetings to share opportunities and drive promotion to clients
- Early Notice of vacancies to providers before advertised elsewhere
- Client referrals generated out of events / unsuccessful lists

Where can we do better?

- Improve our database systems for identifying interested parties per vacancy
- GGN Employment & Enterprise Team need to increase activity in Area 3
- Improve feedback from client needs to team organising tasters/pre-employment training

- Help us promote opportunities to a wider audience
- Meet, understand and promote the activities of our engagement team
- Link us and potential employers to the Fund and Hub





Contributions of Groundwork UK Youth Contract

What worked well?


- Large number of young "NEET" people engaged
- Over 100 young people engaged in a training course, education or an Apprenticeship


What could we have done better?

- Increased the range of training opportunities offered
- Work with more providers/colleges
- Improved the promotional activity thereby increased number of starts & outcomes

What can you help with?

Little now programme has closed for new starts – mostly we would like to see you continue to promote life-long learning linked to employment to young people





Contribution of "Dig in Stay Out" Programme

What worked well?

- Continuous support within custody and then upon release
- Allowing for a "settlement" period immediately upon release of 4 weeks
- Subsidized employment placements for 3- 6 months

Where could we have done better?

- Issues at start up gaining access to prisons
- Programme has been extended due to underspend, and changed no employment placement now
- Could have had a more diverse range of employer engagement

- Help us promote services to young people and partners
- Promote the employment of ex-offenders to clients and employers.





Reduction in long term unemployment

What worked well?

- Provides support to specific client groups who normally miss out
- Universal support during weekly Work Clubs

Where can we do better?

- Need to promote more and secure more clients in Area 3, particularly Leen Valley
- Limited locations acquired for weekly work clubs in Leen Valley
- Need to review the model are we providing support that is needed

- Help us with securing work club locations
- Promoting our services to residents
- Help with developing the model



Contribution of "Talent Match – Young & Successful" programme

- Total of 404 Young People across D2N2, of which 75 are from Area 3
- £392,000 additional funding brought into the area
- 8 Young people engaged in basic skills/training
- 3 Young people in Full Time Education
- 5 Young people volunteering
- Young people completing Work Experience
- 10 Young people have moved into jobs/self employment
- 5 Young people have started Apprenticeships



Contribution of "Talent Match – Young & Successful" programme

What worked well?

- Significant proportion of young people supported in Area 3 (75 out of 404 Total)
- Mentoring approach with young people works very well
- Personalised budgets to support employment, training

Where can we do better?

- Need to co-ordinate support to clients across wider range of partners
- We have difficulties identifying local employer opportunities
- Promotion of programme

- Help link us up with local employers
- Promote our services
- Identify and link us up with more community partners
