

Child Development Review

Rationale:

- Transfer of commissioning responsibilities for Health Visitors and Family Nurse Partnership from October 2015
- Early Intervention City phase 2 – further development of evidence-based programmes and approaches
- Increased focus on joint working with the CCG
- Need to support SSBC – system change and programme rollout
- Continued drive for service improvement and efficiencies



Child Development Review

Outcome:

Improved outcomes for pregnant women, babies, children and young people, which will be achieved through a defined universal and early help pathway of services which are delivered in an integrated way, through a consistent evidence-based approach by a competent and confident workforce.



Child Development Review

Process:

- Establish Review Team
- Establish Governance Group and Steering Group
- Develop an outcomes framework for 0-19 and outcome indicators
- Undertake an analysis of need
- Undertake an analysis of best practice against each outcome
- Identify current provision, gaps and inconsistencies



Child Development Review

Process:

- Consider SSBC programmes and approaches
- Make recommendations based on the findings
- Develop a logic model for each group of recommendations to provide the rationale for inclusion
- Consult on the recommendations, (*current position*) amend appropriately and acquire sign-off
- Produce a diagrammatic pathway of services for professionals
- Produce a family friendly version



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Process:

- Identify potential models for integrated teams
- Undertake an options appraisal for each model
- Consult with stakeholders
- Agree a model
- Develop a draft service specification
- Consult with stakeholders
- Implement the new model (or elements of it if a phased approach is agreed)
- Monitor and evaluate
