Decision Being Taken:	The works planned are for the refurbishment of 4 pool plant filters at Victoria Leisure Centre.
Reasons for the Decision(s)	Currently there is sand appearing in the main pool which means the filters are in need of replacement. We are currently receiving customer complaints. We are not meeting the council's citizens at heart theme with the current problem. Unless the problem is resolved this could result in damages to other parts of the pool plant equipment. The pool water quality could deteriorate very quickly resulting in the closure of the pool and loss of income to the site and reduced attendances/visits to the facility.
Other Options Considered:	If no action is taken then the pool will close resulting in financial loss to the council. This will also result in reputation damage to the council.
