Staff will be working at weekends during the final quarter, concentrating on tenants who we find it difficult to contact during the week. This activity is designed to maximise rent collection and ensure the year-end target will be met.  So far this year we have carried out fewer evictions – 83 compared to 111 at the same point last year.  We continue to sign up as many customers as possible for Direct Debit payments. In December we hit our target of 36.5% of customers signed up to pay by Direct Debit.  A corporate programme of work continues, designed to ensure that the whole of NCH plans for and responds to the challenges of Universal Credit (which will be rolled out in Nottingham in February) and wider welfare reforms. An intensive data collection exercise relating to our tenants continues and we now hold the required data on 5,000 of the 13,000 working age tenants who are likely to be affected by Universal Credit. The required data includes information on bank account ownership, internet access and confidence in using the internet. This data allows us to target those tenants who require additional support. Information sessions will be held for staff to ensure they are able to give appropriate advice, and tenants to ensure they have access to the necessary information to successfully manage any claim they make for Universal Credit.
