Reasons for not consulting

There has been no express consultation about this decision, but regular meetings take place with the Portfolio Holder and Strategic Director of Property regarding Property matters, which may include this matter. ## Background to the decision

14 Church Square is a 2 bedroom flat above the Church Square retail shopping parade. Its acquisition will help facilitate the timely decommissioning and demolition of Church Square.
