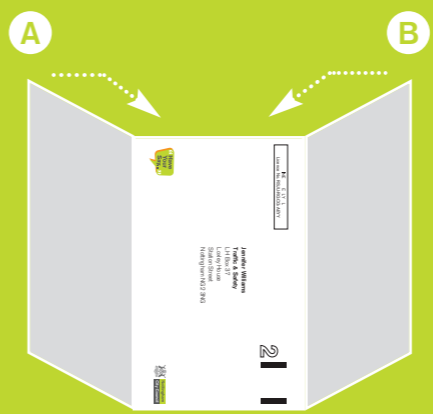

Nottingham City Council wants to hear your views on how we can improve road safety in your area.

In response to road traffic accidents and concerns raised about speeding vehicles along Broxtowe Lane, Nottingham City Council has committed funding to address this matter. Since January 2011 there have been 12 road traffic accidents reported to the police along Broxtowe Lane, resulting in 16 people injured. A third of these accidents involved vehicles speeding and nearly a half involved cyclists. We are interested to know the experiences of local residents who use this road regularly; your views will help us shape our proposals to make sure we deliver a scheme that meets your needs.
