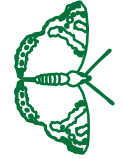


Bulwell Community Meadow - Bulwell, Nottingham - General Arrangement 1:500

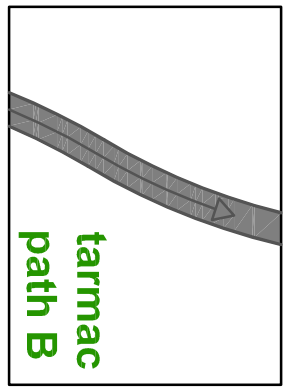
Existing mixed deciduous woodland belt to be maintained (refer to Management Plan. 3.5m chain link fence to be repaired).



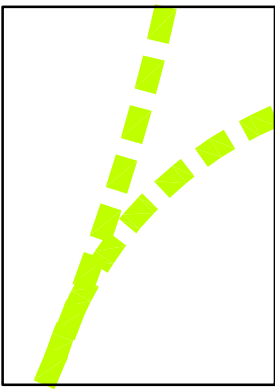
Proposed 1.5m wide timber edged Magnesium Limestone footpath (see detail) with mown edges. Total length = 640 l/m. Central circuit length = 1/3 mile (536.5 l/m) so to run or walk 1 mile would be three laps.



Proposed 2.0m wide 1:12.25 max gradient PCC edged tarmac footpath A. Works to include filling low spots to smooth flowing contours and drop kerb crossing with tactile paving. Total path length = 30 l/m.



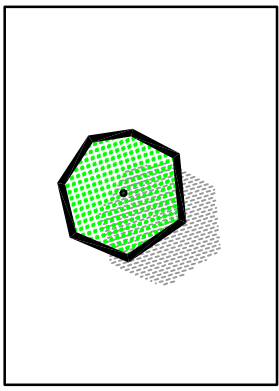
Proposed 2.0m wide 1:12.25 max gradient PCC edged tarmac footpath B. Works to include filling low spots to smooth flowing contours. Total path length = 48.6 l/m.



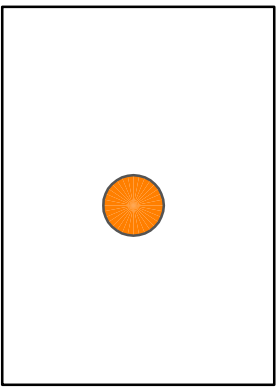
Proposed mown grass footpath routes (existing desire lines to be reviewed on site). Total length = 400 l/m.



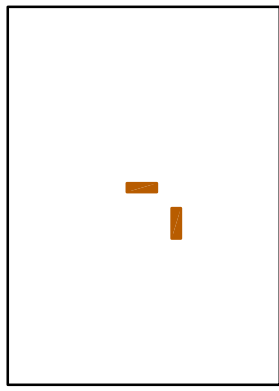
Proposed managed amenity grassland areas. Vegetation clearance, 100mm topsoil + seeding amenity grass mix. Total area = 500 m2.



Proposed native species tree planting. 'Standard' size tree whip tree planting 9 No.



Proposed pedestrian access points to include local artwork, site interpretation signs and bins. Refer to Community Design Workshops drawing & details.



Proposed bench seating. 6 No. Refer to details.



Existing grassland sward to be managed to promote maximum ecological bio-diversity and wildlife interest. Refer to Management Plan.
