### **9 STATEMENT OF LICENSING POLICY**

The Committee considered a report of the Director of Community Protection, including the Draft Statement of Licensing Policy, evidence in support of the retention of the existing City Centre Saturation Policy and a proposed new Berridge, Arboretum, and Radford Saturation Policy.

Mrs Rawson suggested amendments to the wording of paragraph 1.8 of the draft Policy as follows and stated that some re-numbering of Policies would be needed due to the draft currently containing two Policy 5s:

- (1) amend bullet point 6 to read '*To support an annual programme of popular events including Splendour, Goose Fair and the Riverside Festival to ensure a safe and well regulated environment.*';
- (2) add a bullet point 7 stating '*Support residents' expectations that their sleep will not be unduly disturbed between the hours of 23:00 and 07:00.*'.

**RESOLVED**, subject to the amendments indicated above, as agreed by the Committee, to submit the Draft Policy to the Council meeting on 8 July 2013 for approval for consultation.
