Mrs Rawson suggested amendments to the wording of paragraph 1.8 of the draft Policy as follows and stated that some re-numbering of Policies would be needed due to the draft currently containing two Policy 5s:

- (1) amend bullet point 6 to read 'To *support* an annual programme of popular events including Splendour, Goose Fair and the Riverside Festival *to ensure a safe and well regulated environment.*';
- (2) add a bullet point 7 stating 'Support residents' expectations that their sleep will not be unduly disturbed between the hours of 23:00 and 07:00.'.

RESOLVED, subject to the amendments indicated above, as agreed by the Committee, to submit the Draft Policy to the Council meeting on 8 July 2013 for approval for consultation.
