<b>Decision Being Taken:</b>	<b>1) To approve the proposed package of tariff changes outlined in the exempt appendix; 2) To authorise the Corporate Director of Commercial and Operations to implement the proposals, subject to advertising the variation notice.</b>
<b>Reasons for the Decision(s)</b>	<b>Following the successful tariff change delivered in October 2015 and departmental savings delivered in 2016, Parking Services are proposing a freeze to general tariffs in all our multi-storey car parks this year.  The changes we propose in this document have been developed as a result of three large changes in the parking market within Nottingham: the introduction of NET Phase Two, the proliferation of Early Bird tariffs and expansion of the city centre in to areas previously classed as "outer central".</b>
<b>Other Options Considered:</b>	<b>Do nothing: This option has been discounted for the following reason: Every year, Parking Services review all tariffs across Nottingham City Council run car parks to ensure they are fit for purpose. The changes proposed within this document ensure that the car parks are fully utilized and encourage growth in the local economy.</b>
