**Decision Being Taken:** 

Approve Nottingham City Council taking on the Accountable Body role for the D2N2 wide "Invest in D2N2" ERDF bid, to DCLG.

Delegate authority to the Strategic Director Economy to negotiate and enter into a funding agreement with DCLG and contracts with the City Council's delivery partners described in this report.

To appoint a Project Co-ordinator within Development and Growth for the 3 year period of the project (non-executive decision).

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Reasons for the Decision(s) DD 2459 approved £0.375m spend over three years on a project with Marketing Nottingham and Nottinghamshire. This decision is to enable the Council to take on Accountable Body role alongside its partnership role with the work and outputs being delivered by a variety of partners - Marketing Nottingham and Nottinghamshire, Marketing Derby, Destination Chesterfield and Derbyshire Enterprise Partnership. Being Accountable Body the Council will take on overall responsibility for the project, with key outputs being delivered by partners. The separate partners have been working on separate bids with D2N2/DCLG. However, as private limited companies with limited balance sheets, DCLG would not approve them as separate bids. Nottingham City Council has experience in delivering ERDF projects and ensuring compliance and delivery. As a partner of the project already, Nottingham City Council benefits from the project, so acting as Accountable Body helps secure the income from the funding, and ensures best practice across the ERDF bids currently being managed by the Council. The Project Co-ordinator post within Development and Growth will undertake the administration and monitoring required for the bid and the Accountable Body role to ensure that all appropriate information and records are kept. This post will be funded from within the £2,083,491 budget for the project, which is made up from ERDF funding and match funding from partners. That funding is no longer required and the Council is not contributing any match funding. Other Options Considered: Not submitting a bid - rejected as the Council benefits from the financial support and economic benefits of the project Finding another lead partner who could take on the responsibility - rejected as other existing partners did not have the experience that Nottingham City Council has, and inviting a third party in at this stage would delay the bid and risk not securing funding.
