Thank you for your email below (received 15 August).

In the light of the circumstances you have set out in our correspondence (and given that the Commission has previously made a substantive decision to authorise release of part of the permanent endowment) I am able to confirm that we can agree to the trustee's request.

Commission's decision

The Commission concurs with the resolution passed by the council as trustee to expend £700,000 of the charity's permanent endowment in matched funding for the Heritage Lottery grant. The resolution and the Commission's concurrence will only be exercisable if the charity obtains the grant from Heritage Lottery and in no other circumstances. This concurrence replaces, and is not in addition to, the Commission's concurrence dated 20 November 2014.
