Decision Being Taken:	Approval is sought for the acceptance of a one-off grant of £25,000 payable to Nottingham City Council as the Department of Work and Pension's (DWP) contribution to the creation of a partnership which will help to improve employment outcomes or prospects of future employment outcomes for long-term unemployed individuals and groups facing health barriers to attaining and maintaining work. the commissioning of a Health and Employment Support Service for Nottingham citizens.
Reasons for the Decision(s)	The Health and Employment Support service has been commissioned jointly between Nottingham City Council and Nottingham City CCG (a total of £150,000 each over three years). The DWP also wished to make a one-off contribution to the service of £25,000 and used the grant process to set this up. The attached specification for the Health and Employment Support Service gives more detail on the service if required.
