Subject:	Contribution to Greater Notts Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP) development
Total Value:	£35,000 (Type: Revenue)
Decision Being Taken:	Payment of £35,000 to a pooled fund to enable the development of the Greater Notts Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP).
Reasons for the Decision(s)	The Greater Nottinghamshire Health and Care Partners are all contributing, on a pro-rata basis, funds to a central pot of money to enable the commissioning of work to develop the Sustainability and Transformation Plan - which is a mandatory plan that all areas are required to develop with Local Authorities, CCGs and healthcare providers. The plan is being developed with the assistance of external support. The City Council contribution to this is actually one of the smallest overall contributions, with the majority of funds being provided by the 4 Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG's) and the major healthcare providers in the area. This has been discussed at Portfolio Holder Briefings.
Other Options Considered:	The other options are: 1) to provide no support to the STP - this is rejected as we are a small contributor to the overall funding for this work, and we have a significant amount to gain, therefore this would not be a recommended approach 2) to provide more support than we have been asked to - this was rejected as we feel that the calculation of what we should consider is an appropriate proportion
