1 Purpose

1.1 To consider the results of the Citizens' Survey 2016.

2 Action required

3 Background information

3.1 The Citizens' Survey took place in October and November 2016 and gathered citizens' perceptions on a variety of subjects including health and wellbeing, community cohesion, feelings about Nottingham, satisfaction with the Council and experiences due to the current economic climate.

3.2 The results of the survey were published in May 2017. They will help the Committee to gather evidence to contribute the proposed review topics discussed at the meeting on 5 April 2017, and also help identify possible topics for future scrutiny.
