	Capital Programme & major works	hopper needs to be replaced as the seals are broken. The chutes themselves are fine but require cleaning. Work to the high rise chutes will be complete this financial year. Low rise bin chute surveys will happen next through a planned programme of work.	
		Proposals from the fire risk assessments is to install sprinklers into all the high rise across the City including the following upgrades - intercom, fire alarm, smoke detectors. Installation of PA systems to communal landing areas. This will be a two year project starting in 2018.

		Birkin Avenue fencing works are all complete.	

Coleby Avenue removal of fencing - this has now been completed with a positive reaction from the residents.

Norton Street - Phase three commenced on site and expect completion in October. This project is still ongoing on site and will be completed shortly. Delayed due to private residents opting into the project at a later date.

Parking solution at the Woodlands flats being collated after fire risk assessment - site visit has been made with the contractor, quotation has been received, working with tenancy estate management team to seek a solution.

Grander designs

Sutton House, Radford - 31 flats have been refurbished with new kitchen and level access shower - open plan. Grander designs work to follow.

Sutton House lift has been assessed, and is in good mechanical order, and so an aesthetic upgrade will be looked at..

Church Square Scheme now has Executive Board Approval to construct 17 new family homes. The site has now transferred into NCH's ownership and NCH will also own and manage the new homes after construction. On target for 23/03/18 completion.

Hopedale Close Nine brand new homes, delivered by NCH's in house team are now under construction. Public highway has now been hoarded with
