1. Approval to advertise a Measured Term Contract for a maintenance and water testing package that incorporates		
both Sneinton Market and Old Market Square Water Features.		
2. Delegate the contract award decision to the Corporate Director of Commercial and Operations to the most economically		
advantageous tender received.		
The maintenance of the Old Market Square and Sneinton Market water features are currently being managed under		
separate short-term contracts. The budget is managed by the Highways and Energy Infrastructure Service. The maintenance of		
the water features requires specialist knowledge and skill set, as such it is proposed to progress an external tender		
process to seek the most economically advantageous outcome. The intention is to award the contract to a single contractor who will maintain both water features for		
a four year period.		
Do nothing - this would mean that the fountains would not be routinely serviced (this is essential) and ultimately lead to the fountains		
failing, which is unacceptable.		
Continue with the current arrangements and award 1 year contracts for the maintenance of the individual water features which		
would not be the most efficient method or provide value for money.
