Title:	Health and Wellbeing Board Commissioning Sub Committee Terms of Reference

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Brief summary:	<p>The Health and Wellbeing Board established the Health and Wellbeing Board Commissioning Sub Committee in 2015 as a commissioner-only body, bringing together commissioners from Nottingham City Council and NHS Nottingham City Clinical Commissioning Group to take strategic funding decisions delegated to it by the Board.</p> <p>In order to ensure that it remains fit for purpose, the Terms of Reference for the Commissioning Sub Committee have been reviewed and a proposed revised Terms of Reference is attached. The Health and Wellbeing Board Commissioning Sub Committee was consulted on the proposed revisions at its meeting on 13 December 2017.</p>
