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

As you can see since the car parking permit scheme was introduced last year, parking of students cars has been an issue. Mainly because they are not permitted to park anywhere else on the Grove, so they are now taking it upon themselves to park on Loxley, Twyford, Croxall and Wichnor Close. In these areas I am informed that a large majority were against the scheme at first. Hence the main reason why the students are now crammed into our once quiet corner of Clifton Grove.

We as a community feel we are now being discriminated against because of this and are now asking for your help. If you have experienced these problems and are really annoyed by the parking issues, we are asking you to complain via the attached form. Presently, this lady has allegedly only received one complaint.

Can I advise that you don't need a parking permit for parking on your own drive, it is only for on street parking during the hours of 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday, and they are free to residents, there is no charge.

I have experience dangerous double parking of which bin lorries have been unable to get access. If they can't then no emergency service could either. There has also been rubbish dumped from cars and! have experienced verbal abuse from them.

If you don't do this now, then it will never happen and we will just have to put up with this. I haven't paid £250k for a car park that's open to students from 5am till 6pm at night. There is plenty of parking for them near to the University including a brand new park and ride.

It's now up to you to make this change, for now and the future.
