

NOTICE OF CONSULTATION

PROPOSED EXTENSION TO THE NOTTINGHAM CITY COUNCIL CITY WIDE PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDERS IN RESPECT OF DOGS

Notice is hereby given that Nottingham City Council (“the Council”) proposes to **EXTEND** the following four Public Spaces Protection Orders (“PSPO”) under Section 60 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014

- i) Nottingham City Council Dogs on Lead by Direction Public Spaces Protection Order 2016;
- ii) Nottingham City Council Dogs on Leads Public Spaces Protection Order 2016;
- iii) Nottingham City Council Dogs Exclusion Public Spaces Protection Order 2016; and
- iv) Nottingham City Council Fouling of Land by Dogs and Requirement to Produce Device for or Other Suitable Means of Removing Dog Faeces Public Spaces Protection Order 2016.
