

Nottingham City Council Winter Pressures Spending Plan 2019/2020

On 2nd October the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care announced an additional £240m social care investment to ease winter pressures on the NHS, aimed at reducing delayed transfers of care and to be allocated to councils based on the adult social care relative needs formula. This equated to £1.550m for Nottingham City. The funding was initially until March 2019 however the government has extended this funding until 2020 which will equate to a further £1.550m for Nottingham City.

This grant funding has conditions attached and quarterly performance monitoring has been required under the below sub sections :

- Reablement / Intermediate care places in residential care/ nursing
 - Reablement / Intermediate care in own home
- Dedicated discharge team embedded in domiciliary providers
 - Additional domiciliary care packages not reablement
