1 REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

1.1 Following the track improvements that took place in 2015 a number of required design changes have been identified which need to be rectified in order to allow the Stadium to function better and to ensure that the Stadium / Track complies with UK Athletics facility standards. The works will improve the Pole Vault take off box, Install new 7m take-off bars to the triple jump runway and completely resurface the high jump runway.

- 4.3 The Head of Service for Public Realm will need to put in place the appropriate processes to ensure compliance to the external grant award conditions to avoid clawback of grant

Project Brief: Following the Track improvements that took place in 2015 there has been a number of design problems that have been identified and need to be rectified in order to allow the stadium to function better and to ensure that the Stadium / Track complies with UK Athletics facility standards.

- The Pole Vault take off box,
- Install 2 new 7m jump bars into the long jump runway
- Resurface the entire High Jump Fan.
- Project management
- Site Surveys and UK Athletics Accreditation.
- CDM regulations


These works are essential to ensure that the track remains compliant with UK Athletics competition compliance rules.
