Additional Payment of a Management Fee to Nottingham City Homes

Total Value:

£74,000 (Type: Revenue)

Decision Being Taken:

To provide £74,000 in 2019/20 to Nottingham City Homes (NCH), in addition to the Management Fee approved in the Medium Term Financial Plan by the full Council on 4 March 2019 (and any subsequent approvals), to meet the costs incurred in the delivery of services to the Win-Wood Extra Care scheme.

Reasons for the Decision(s) The Council has built a new Extra Care scheme at the site of Woodthorpe and Winchester Court in Sherwood, which forms part of the Council's housing stock. NCH manages the Council's housing stock and is paid a Management Fee for this function and, in order to fund the additional support required by this scheme, an adjustment in the fee is required.

> It is proposed that the additional service charge income generated from tenants at this scheme is used to fund the additional Management Fee to NCH to pay for services provided to these tenants. The services provide support to residents to increase or maintain their independence, including flexible and tailored support to enable residents to stay in their own home for longer. The cost of these services will be funded by the additional income from service charges and so is cost neutral to the Housing Revenue Account. The estimated values of the additional service charges for 2019/20 is £74,000, based on the scheme opening at the start of August 2019, and £111,000 for the full year of 2020/21 (this amount will be included for approval in the total Management Fee proposed in the 2020/21 budget).

Other Options Considered:

To not fund NCH for delivery of these services: this option was rejected because this would result in reductions to service to the tenants, who are entitled to them by payment of a service charge.
