Notice of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations 2019

1. Notice is hereby given that Nottingham City Council is conducting a review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations that fall within the City of Nottingham.
2. The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the Parliamentary constituencies of Nottingham East, Nottingham North and Nottingham South has published their recommendations for each ward within the City of Nottingham. These proposals have been published on the council's website and are available for inspection at the council's offices at Loxley House, Station Street, Nottingham, NG2 3NG.
3. The Council welcomes views or comments from electors and any persons or bodies that have expertise in access to premises or facilities for persons with any type of disability. Local political parties and Nottingham City councillors will also be consulted.
4. Comments may relate to existing or proposed polling districts or polling places. Persons or bodies making representations should, where possible, provide alternative premises that could be used as polling places.

Monday, 7 th October	Public consultation period closes.
Monday, 11 th November	Final proposals are considered at the full meeting of Nottingham City Council.
Sunday, 1 st December	The revised electoral register is published. The revised polling districts, polling places and polling stations would be utilised in any elections held after this date.
