You are invited to take part in a 6 mile guided walk led by members of Nottingham's Local Access Forum.

Start: 11.00 am – Southglade Leisure Centre, NG5 5GU

Meet outside entrance. Nearest Bus Stop 'Southglade Leisure Centre', **Brown Line 16**

Approximate Finish: 2:30 pm - Southglade Leisure Centre, NG5 5GU

Limited toilet facilities along route. You may wish to bring a snack/drink for during the walk. Options for a shorter walk available.

- Walk part of the Great Northern Railway Line and see the Beeching Axe Bench
- Explore Bestwood Country Park, Bestwood Lodge and learn more about the history of Nell Gwynn and her handkerchiefs!
 - We'll pass Emmanuel Church, a Victorian church built in 1869
 - Explore Southglade Park



Please note: a few paths are steep in places; some can be muddy. Parts of the route are unsuitable for wheelchairs and mobility scooters. All children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Participants walk at own risk. Dogs on leads welcome.
